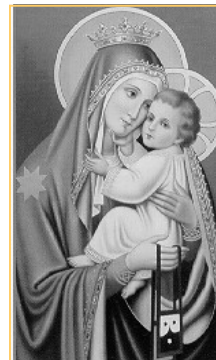

Archbishop John R. Quinn

Archbishop John R. Quinn died on Thursday, June 22nd.

Archbishop Quinn was 88 years of age.

He served as the sixth Archbishop of San Francisco from April 26, 1977 until December 27, 1995 and was President of the National Conference of Catholic Bishops from 1977 to 1980.

A Vigil will be held on Sunday, July 9, at 7:00 p.m. in St. Mary's Cathedral. The Funeral Mass will take place there on Monday, July 10, at 10:00 a.m. The Vigil and Funeral Mass will be live streamed on the archdiocesan website.
