Important reminders for parents whose children are preparing to receive the following sacraments in 2017-2018:

First Holy Communion & Reconciliation – Grades 1 & 2

Preparation for First Holy Communion and Reconciliation is a **two year** sacramental preparation program *beginning in 1st grade*. In accordance with Archdiocesan guidelines, children are required to complete two years of religious education to be properly prepared to meet Jesus in these two sacraments.

Please register online for the First Holy Communion/ Reconciliation program if your child:

- is entering 1st grade in 2017-2018 *or*
- has completed one year of religious education either at St. Patrick Church, another parish program, or at a Catholic school, and will be entering 2nd grade this coming school year.

Confirmation – Grades 6-8

Confirmation is a **three year** sacramental preparation program at St. Patrick Church *beginning in 6th grade*.

Please register online for the Confirmation program if your child:

- is entering the 6th grade in the 2017-2018 school year *or*
- has completed at least 2 years of Confirmation preparation either in a parish program or at a Catholic school and will be entering 8th grade this coming school year.
